# **CREDIT PROGRAM INFORMATION**

#### **DATES AND TIMES**

Night School: All classes run Monday and Wednesday evenings from 6:00 – 9:30 p.m.

**Summer School:** All classes run Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

Online Summer School: All classes run Monday to Friday for 5.5 hours per day, however, there is more flexibility as to when students

are expected to be online.

#### **FORMATION OF CLASSES**

All classes are conditional on space, teacher availability and sufficient enrolment and may be cancelled or transferred to a different location than listed.

#### WHAT IS THE ATTENDANCE POLICY?

A student who has registered for a credit course but is absent on the first day without giving prior notification to the Site Administrator or the Continuing Education office may lose their spot in the class.

Regular attendance/daily login is crucial for student success. One evening of Night School or one day of Summer School is equivalent to approximately one full week of instruction in the regular school year. A student is expected to be punctual and attend every class/login daily. Absence for personal activities or vacation is **not** acceptable. Failure to attend may lead to withdrawal from the program.

#### IS THERE HOMEWORK?

Continuing Education courses cover an entire year's work in a compressed period of time and students must be prepared to allocate sufficient time to work at home every day.

# WHEN ARE FINAL SUMMATIVE EVALUATIONS COMPLETED?

Final Summative evaluations will take place towards the end of each session. Check your student handbook as to the specific dates. Students who fail to complete their final summative evaluations jeopardize their chances of earning the credit.

# WHEN DO I GET MY REPORT CARD?

# Mid-term Report Cards

Students will receive a mid-term report card in the middle of the program. For Night School, this would be on the 13<sup>th</sup> evening. For Summer School, this would be on the 10<sup>th</sup> day.

#### Final Report Cards

- Final Report Cards will be emailed to students to their BYOD email address (<a href="mailto:nnnnnn@pdsb.net">nnnnnnn@pdsb.net</a>). This link will be available for 7 days only. Students are recommended to download and save their report card.
- · For Night School courses, students will receive their final report card, and review their final summative on the last evening of classes.
- For Summer School, 55-hour session classes taught in the first session, students will receive their final report card and review their final summative, on the last day of the 10-day program.
- For Summer School, 55-hour session classes taught in the second session and full session courses, students will receive their final report card, and review their final summative, on the last day of the 20-day program.

A final mark will be submitted to the student's home school shortly after the end of the program. However, students are encouraged to take the Night School or Summer School report card to their day school and have their guidance counsellor add it to their transcript.

#### WHEN IS FULL DISCLOSURE?

A mark for your senior course (i.e. Gr. 11 or 12) will appear on your transcript if you have not withdrawn from the course by two (2) instructional days after the midterm report card is issued. The Full Disclosure deadline is listed in the student handbook.

# **HOW DO I WITHDRAW FROM A CLASS?**

Students may withdraw from a course by:

- Having the guidance counsellor contact Continuing Education, if the student is still registered in a day school; or
- Contacting the administrator at the Night or Summer School site and requesting withdrawal. Students under 18 must have parental permission.

# **HOW DO I GET TO SCHOOL?**
