

What Should I Expect From an Exam at RFH?

Some Tips & Information to Help **YOU** Be Successful

Step 1: Before You LEAVE for school

Step 1: Before You LEAVE for school

Step 2: Arriving at school

When you arrive at school:

- Place all your personal belongings in your locker
- Bring only <u>necessary items</u> with you to class



*Don't forget your <u>textbook</u> or any other materials you may need to return!



Step 3: Where Do I Go?



Where do I write my Exam?

Unless you've been told otherwise, you will write your exam in your <u>usual</u> classroom location.

Step 4: Make your way to class... on time!

Arriving a few minutes early will help you to ensure you feel prepared and collected before the exam begins.

<u>Tip:</u> doing this will allow you to <u>pick your seat</u>, <u>set up your desk</u> and take some time to <u>look over your notes</u> one last time.

Any lost time due to being late will NOT be made up.

Step 4: Make your way to class... on time!

PLEASE NOTE:



The School Bell will ring at our usual time 8:17 am followed by "Oh Canada", prayer and announcements.

8:30am is the time that exam WRITING begins



Step 5: Getting Ready

Once ready to begin, your teacher will ask you to place all bags/study notes/personal items etc. at the **front of the room**.

Only writing utensils and necessary items (i.e a calculator)

will be allowed on your desk.









Step 6: The Exam

The content of every exam will vary by course, but they will all contain a **cover page containing**important exam details including mark breadowns and

suggested timing.



Step 7: Completing your exam

Once you've completed your exam make sure you check it over to ensure you haven't missed anything.

• Your teacher will then collect your exam, at which point you will be expected to remain at your desk until the exam period is complete (10:30am).

You MAY NOT leave even if you finish very early

What if.... I need to go to the washroom?

If you have to use the washroom during the exam, you must raise your hand, at which point another teacher will come to escort you to the washroom.

What if....I need to go to my locker



- You can access your locker **before** your exam.
- All exams are to be completed @ 10:30am, at which point you may <u>access your locker.</u>
