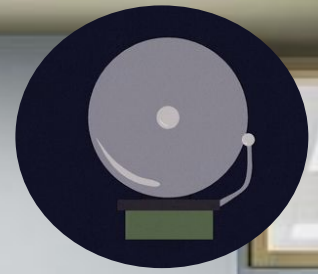

# Step 1: Before You LEAVE for school

- Set your alarm (even 2) a few minutes early. That way you will not be late or feel rushed.



- Ensure you have all necessary materials (calculator, pen, pencil, etc) to write your exam.

- Set your alarm minutes early. That way you will be ready when the alarm rings.



**DON'T FORGET** To pack any **course materials** that needs to be **returned** (i.e. textbooks).

# Step 1: Before You LEAVE for school

**BEFORE!! YOU LEAVE YOUR HOUSE...**

Ask yourself “**Am I in Full Uniform??**”





# Step 2: Arriving at school

When you arrive at school:

- Place all your personal belongings in your locker
- Bring only necessary items with you to class



\*Don't forget your textbook or any other materials you may need to return!





# Step 3: Where Do I Go?

Unless you've been told otherwise, you will write your exam in your usual **classroom location.**



# Step 4: Make your way to class... on time!

Arriving a few minutes early will help you to ensure you feel prepared and collected before the exam begins.

Tip: doing this will allow you to **pick your seat, set up your desk** and take some time to **look over your notes** one last time.

**Any lost time due to being late will NOT be made up.**





# Step 4: Make your way to class... on time!

## PLEASE NOTE:

The School Bell will ring at our usual time 8:17 am followed by “Oh Canada”, prayer and announcements.



8:30am is the time that exam **WRITING** begins

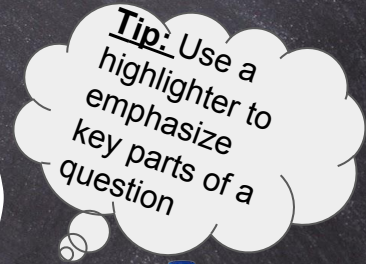




# Step 5: Getting Ready

Once ready to begin, your teacher will ask you to place all bags/study notes/personal items etc. at the front of the room.

Only writing utensils and necessary items (i.e a calculator) will be allowed on your desk.



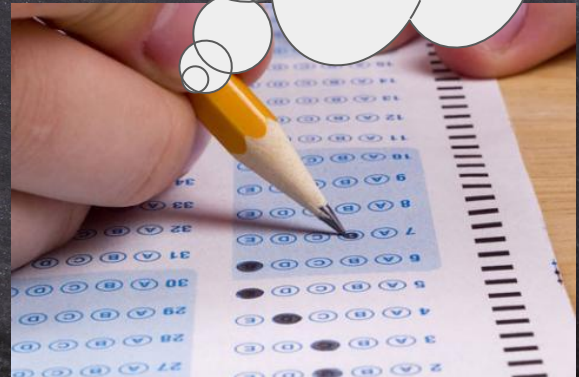
\*water/comfort items/small snacks are ok too but check with your teacher first!



# Step 6: The Exam

The content of every exam will vary by course, but they will all contain a **cover page** containing **important exam details** including mark breakdowns and suggested timing.

**Remember:** An exam is **just a longer test**. Be mindful of suggested timing/marks, but don't let it alarm you





# Step 7: Completing your exam

Once you've completed your exam **make sure you check it over** to ensure you haven't missed anything.

- Your teacher will then collect your exam, at which point you will be expected to remain at your desk until the exam period is complete (10:30am).

\*You MAY NOT leave even if you finish very early\*



What if.... I need to go to the  
washroom?



If you have to use the washroom during the exam,  
you must raise your hand, at which point another  
teacher will come to **escort** you to the washroom.




# What if....I need to go to my locker

- All exams are to be completed @ 10:30am, at which point you may access your locker.
